Food Pantry

The First Place Food pantry has been certified as a "Choice Pantry." In February our Food Pantry became the 9th "Choice Pantry" in the five counties served by Shared Harvest Food Bank. OSU Extension under the direction of Burlee County F.E.E.D. Alliance created the Rainbow of Choice System. Foods are shelved according to color coded food

groups and clients are allowed a pre-determined number of choices per food group. This system ensures that clients choose a variety of different foods so they can provide healthy, balanced meals and snacks for themselves and their families. Cooking demos are provided twice monthly for our clients. All volunteers have participated in 4 hours of training for the transition to Choice Pantry.
